IAL FIELD TRIP to FLEMINGTON RACECOURSE

Join us at Flemington Racecourse on Wednesday 17th August at 10am - 12pm to find out all about their award winning in situ desalination system. In Dallas, USA in 2014 it was the recipient of the WaterReuse Project of the Year, taking honours over other international water projects in Abu Dhabi, West Africa and Russia.

The in situ desalination system, Desalin8, is a new Australian technology for recovering fresh water from a brackish groundwater aquifer, and utilises a desalination process that uses membranes to remove freshwater water from saline aquifer water, completely below ground.

The VRC piloted the Desalin8 technology with the support of City West Water's Business Resource Efficiency program.

You will also hear about aspects of the track-watering and general garden irrigation for one of Victoria and Australia's iconic sites.

Enter via the Gate off Epsom Road, and follow the green line to a carpark just past the Flemington Operations Centre, paying special attention to the posted speed limit!
